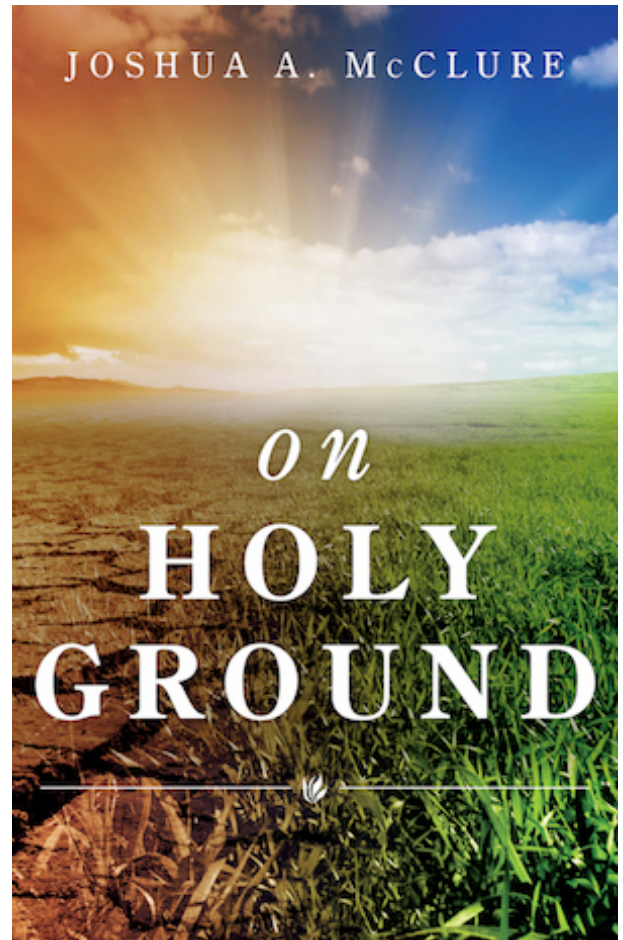

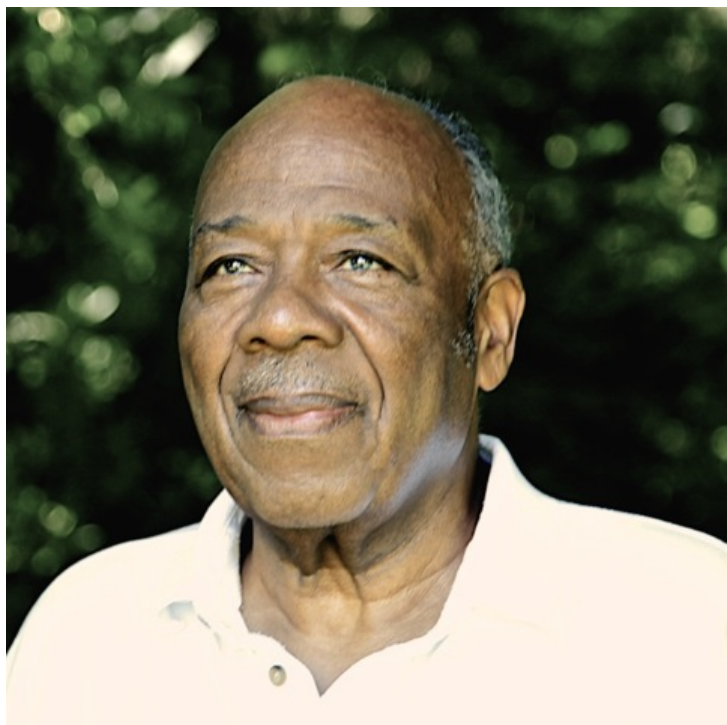

Q: What does the word “holiness” mean as it relates to God?

A: God is eternally separate and distinct from all impurity.

Q: Can a person become holy on their own by rigorous study?

A: No. God gives us the Holy Spirit to help us obey and to give power to overcome sin.

Q: When God says, “Be holy as I am holy,” what does he mean?

Q: Is holiness the same as righteousness?

A: Righteousness is about the relationship with God. Holiness is being set apart to Him.

Q: How can one live holy?

Q: How is repentance important to God’s call to be holy?

A: In repentance we stand together with Christ as we bare our inner selves to God’s certain light.

Q: What is the danger of misinterpreting God’s call to be holy?

A: We may think it has to do with dress, refraining from things we deem unacceptable to God, etc., rather than focusing all our thoughts on God allowing him to grow us into his image and likeness.
