

# YOU WERE DESIGNED

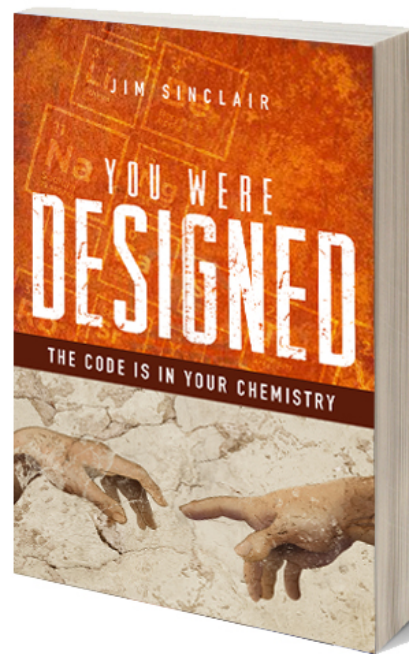
The Code Is in Your Chemicals

## **Suggested Interview Questions Jim Sinclair:**

**1. What made you first start investigating this subject?**

Soon after I first learnt about the subject of 'Bible numerics' I noticed some interesting 'coincidences'. The first was the fact that the number 8 in the Bible code is often associated with, "A new start" and in the periodic table the existence of 8 electrons in a shell is the signal for the start of a new shell. I worked with the semiconductors, elements in column 14 which are carbon, silicon, germanium, tin and lead and came across a number of other 'coincidences' associating them with, "The natural creation" which is what the Bible numeric code associates with the number four. I kept coming across associations of that type until I started to wonder if there was more to it than just coincidences.

**2. Do you think what you have written is the complete description of the whole subject?**

Definitely not!!!! This book is to open up an entirely new subject for investigation, discussion, argument and I do not expect the final word on the subject will be written for many years yet – in fact I would be very disappointed if no-one ever added anything to what I have written.

### **3. What is the background of the subject of 'Bible numerics'?**

In the original text of the Bible the Old Testament was written in an ancient Hebrew language and the New Testament was written in an ancient form of Greek. In both those languages the symbols were used for both letters of the alphabet and for numbers. You could in fact translate the whole original text of the Bible into numbers instead of letters and do arithmetic on it. If you do that you often find that when the Bible in words is talking about a particular subject the numbers of the associated passage are multiples of a particular number which is a key to that subject. At this time we do not know what understanding the ancient scholars had of the numeric code, there is one reference in the Gospel of Mark chapter 8 verses 17 to 21 where Jesus specifically drew his disciples' attention to the numbers involved in the two incidents of feeding large numbers of people with loaves and fishes. In modern times about a hundred or so years ago the code was re-discovered by a group of Bible scholars. The names Ivan Panin and Ethelbert Bullinger are associated with them; these two gentlemen have left us with a number of books and shorter articles on the subject but interest in it seems to have died out fairly quickly after the passing of that group and it pretty much lay dormant for 50 or 60 years.

### **4. Has the Bible numeric code ever been proven in the strictly scientific sense?**

I am fairly sure that no-one in modern times has ever sat down with a set of original texts and worked through a comprehensive test of all the associations with a statistical test at the end of it. On the other hand it is not difficult for anyone who wants to test a particular passage of interest and prove that a non-random number code is buried in it, there is an example of how that can be done in the Appendix of this book.

### **5. You have written a book about a subject that has not been scientifically proven - why?**

Just because it is not proven does not mean it is wrong! It is just that it has not yet been completely tested. 100 years ago when there were people actively interested in Bible numerics the modern probability theory did not exist and the early calculations that were to lead to modern statistical methods were only being practiced in gambling dens and race tracks – places where devout Christians did not go. Bible numerics, however, is not the central theme of the book that I have written. I have taken the numeric associations and matched them with another series of numbers and found associations that definitely can be proven to be significant and those provable associations are what the book is about.

### **6. Is a scientist allowed to believe in God?**

Certainly!!! In fact we are encouraged to use the scientific method to prove the power of God. There is a record in the book of Judges chapter 6 verses 36 to 40 of Gideon conducting a scientific experiment and God is quite happy for someone who is willing to

believe the evidence to test the power of God in this way so that his/her faith will stand on a foundation of personal experience. God is the ultimate expert in knowledge of all scientific disciplines. He welcomes honest and open minded research by scientists who are willing to say, "The data I have collected cannot be fitted in with the known laws of physics, chemistry or nuclear science so it indicates the effect of a supernatural force!" Conversely He totally rejects people whether accredited scientists or not who start with the prejudice, 'I will not believe unless I can fit what I see in with the natural World". God is a supernatural power and the scientific method is equally as able to identify the actions of that supernatural power as it is to identify the actions of natural physics and chemistry.

## **7. Do you think that this book proves that God exists?**

For me it does, I always wanted to have a God of evidence and this is evidence; but that question raises a much deeper and more significant question for which each one of us has an individual answer. Do you as an individual WANT TO have a God of evidence? God has supplied us with enough evidence so that someone who is willing to take that evidence at face value and admit the possible existence of a supernatural God will be supported in their experience but there are two different standards of proof in operation. The legal system is based on forcing people who don't want to believe something to accept it against their will and God specifically does not do that. The most important question is, "Do you want to have a supernatural God of evidence"? If so the evidence is available; but if you do not want a God then He will not force himself upon you in the legalistic sense.
