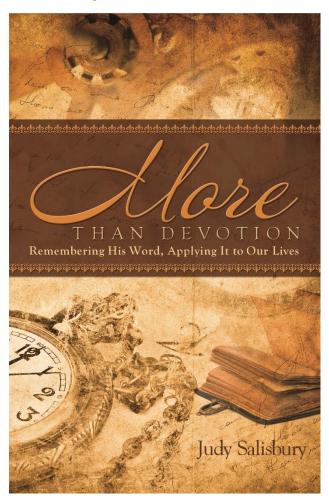
MORE THAN DEVOTION
