As early as he can remember, Robert “Bob” Wilkinson dreamed of becoming a pilot. Not wasting any time reaching his goal, he completed his first solo flight at the age of sixteen and landed a full time job as a first officer on a very, very old DC-3 at the age of nineteen.

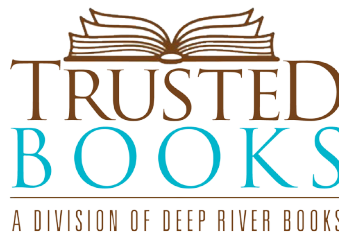
Bob trained at the University of Southern California and the Air-line Pilots Association. His career as a pilot lasted over forty years which included flying Boeing 737 and 767 aircrafts around the world covering international routes from North America to Asia, South America, Europe and Israel. He is also a certified aircraft accident investigator and former member of the International Society of Air Safety Investigators. He served as part of the investigation team on the tragic accident of Swiss Air 111 in Nova Scotia.

Bob earned a diploma in Bible from Liberty University. For over thirty-five years, he has taught Bible classes to university students, as well as to adults at his church.

He still teaches at a flight college and lives with his wife, Shelagh, in Nova Scotia, Canada.

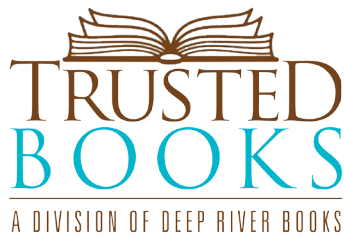

Suggested Interview Questions for Robert Wilkinson author of

1. ***Journey from The Great Palace*** is more than just an exciting novel for young readers 10 and up, it is a Bible study. Please explain how this book uses Fiction to bring to life the history of Jesus.
2. What are some of the challenges in writing Christian historical fiction?
3. One of the main characters is a young angel named Rachael. How do you use this Fictional character to enhance actual events of the Bible?
4. The novel covers the entire life of Jesus from the heavenly realm to earth and to the cross. For some, this may be the first time they have heard the full Gospel story of Jesus. What is the most important thing you hope the reader takes away from this book?
5. Do you think that the use of Fiction may distract from the Biblical message?
6. What is the best way for a reader to use ***Journey from the Great Palace*** as a Bible study.
7. In the back of the book we find references to dozens of Scriptures that you weave into the writing of the book. Should a reader stop and read each Bible passage at the same time as they read the book? Or do you suggest that the reader finish the novel first and then study the Scriptures?
8. Something interesting about you—you began flying planes at the age of 16 and became a first officer at the age of 19. How did your 40 plus years as as a pilot fit into the writing of this book?
9. What was the most unexpected thing you experienced while writing ***Journey from The Great Palace***?
