

Suggested Interview Questions For David V. Burdick, author of Blair's Gap

Silencing a Multi-Generational Curse

Q: Who is your intended audience?

A: *Blair's Gap* is intended for all those searching for, but not yet finding, the truth of Christ, the separation of the New Testament from the Old Testament, the difference between living under the law and living with Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit, under the law He has written in our hearts. What was actually meant by the tearing of the veil before the Holy of Holies when Christ gave up His life for our salvation? *Blair's Gap* is intended for the seekers that have not yet found the peace that surpasses all understanding.

Q: What idea would you most hope that the reader would take away from reading Blair's Gap?

A: Not unlike a starving man eating whatever morsel he can find, we are all born with a God-shaped void that we instinctively try to fill with whatever new marble we can find. What I've learned is that a quart bottle can no more be filled with marbles than can a God-shaped void be filled with anything but God through Christ. There is always empty space and something missing. We must stop to recognize the shape of our void before we can fill it. *Blair's Gap* intends to help the reader recognize the common emptiness of man that can only be filled by God through Christ.

Q: How is *Blair's Gap* different from any other Christian-based book that the reader might purchase?

A: So often, Christian-based literature concentrates on bringing the reader to salvation through personal testimony and logic, but stops there. *Blair's Gap* tries to go a step further by discussing what comes next. Once we have found,



understood, and accepted the keys to the kingdom, what then? Once we have secured the way to the narrow gate, what if any expectations does the Creator then place upon His creation? If salvation is free to all who believe and accept Christ, what further role and responsibility does man have in the fulfillment of God's plan?

Q: What specific message or warning would you give to the reader who has expressed an interest in searching out the actual location of Blair's Gap?

A: Blair's Gap is not a location in Pennsylvania for the reader to seek out. Blair's Gap is an individual's point of awareness, the point in our spiritual journey that we become aware of our responsibility to fulfill our Father's desires. Man can simply be saved by God through Christ or they can chose to make life-altering decisions that carry rewards and consequences, in this life and the next.

Q: What audience might *Blair's Gap* attract that wouldn't normally be inclined to purchase a book directed at Christians?

A: Anyone interested in séances, psychic readings, ghostly apparitions, the summoning of familiar spirits, and/or the use of Ouija boards would likely find *Blair's Gap* to be a useful tool in navigating the minutia that surrounds true spiritualism; our ability to hear and respond to the voice of God's Holy Spirit. Séances, psychic readings, ghostly apparitions, the summoning of familiar spirits, and Ouija boards were the backdrop of my youth and what I fought to reconcile as an adult.

Q: You've written a couple of Christian books now. How is this book different from your other writings?

A: My last book was a personal collection of spiritually inspired poetry. *Blair's Gap* is a non-fictional recounting of a family's sixty-year journey to self-discovery and spiritual awakening. It is a story of liberation and freedom from a curse that had plagued the men of my family for generations.

Q: What surprises or discoveries did you encounter in the writing of *Blair's Gap* and the telling of your story?



A: *Blair's Gap* was a book of family healing; it was a means to allow my family to share their secrets and thereby cast off the bonds imposed by those secrets. My sister and I found that we were able to replace the darkness of our childhood with the desire to seek out all that is good and of God.
