




Being His Light in Darkness

Suggested Interview Questions for Rebecca J. Nolley author of *Shine: Being His Light in Darkness*

Q: As a new author whom not many people know, could you tell us a bit about yourself?

A: Honestly, I'm just a regular person—a wife, mother, teacher, and missionary. I grew up in the church, where I started taking mission trips in high school. Those trips fueled my heart for missions and the lost. Since then, I've traveled to many places, including Morocco, Ukraine, and Costa Rica. My family currently lives in Uganda. I'm a certified teacher and love teaching children, including my own. However, my love for teaching has extended to teaching women the Word of God. I teach in a variety of forums, including on the radio, at conferences, and in Bible studies.

Q: What led you to write Shine?

A: The Holy Spirit. No, really. I had never even considered writing, until I was on a women's retreat and the Lord prompted me to write a Bible study that contained a missional heart. First I said no, then I cried, but I eventually responded in obedience and made a five-year commitment to the Lord. Even though it was the hardest thing I have ever done, it was also the most amazing. Nothing compares to studying God's Word.

Q: What is the primary purpose of this Bible study?

A: To reveal to women their role in God's mission to bring salvation to all people. We are all called to be lights to the world. What that looks like will be different for every person, but my goal is to help women understand what that looks like for them.

Q: What are three take-aways that you hope women will gain from this study?

A: That they will understand the theme of light throughout the entire Word of God, that they will understand their purpose in being God's light to this world, and that they will move out from fear and live an abundant life glorying God.

Q: Who is your primary audience?

A: My primary audience is women (though men are called to be lights too). I feel led to speak to women of all ages that are in the church and looking to grow in their understanding of God's Word. I want to encourage



women that it's not just the missionaries who are called to bring hope to this dark world, and I want to guide them through the Word of God so that they can see for themselves God's heart for the world and His purpose for their lives. God's light shines through all of us, and we all have a mission to be lights.

Q: Why a Bible study and not a book?

A: This is a personal study that will be unique to each and every person. God has called each of us to good works to shine His light into the world, and that is something that can't be dictated in a book but instead by the Holy Spirit. A book conveys your opinion and thoughts, whereas a study guides people through God's opinion and thoughts.

Q: What is the time commitment to this study?

A: It is an eight-week study, with five lessons each week. Each lesson will take an average of 20 minutes depending on what the Lord reveals to each person.

Q: What makes this study different from others?

A: First, I use a lot of scripture because I believe that scripture proves scripture and the whole Bible is unified in its message. Second, I write like I talk and I wanted a more informal tone so that women could relate and feel welcomed into the conversation. Finally, many studies are more inward focused, and while there is nothing wrong with that, I wanted an outward focus on the outpouring of our faith and what it looks like to extend our thoughts, motivations, and actions to include the people around us, our country, and the whole world. "For God so loved the world," not just me.

Q: What has God taught you through this process?

A: God has taught me obedience. When this task seemed impossible, when I had to make sacrifices, when I felt completely inadequate, I just had to walk in obedience to what God had asked me to do. When it all comes down to it, it doesn't matter if this study is successful, if people like it, or how many copies I sell. What matters is that I was committed to His Word.

Q: Do you plan on writing other studies?

A: Yes, I'll continue to write studies that have a missional heart, which will include "Shout", "Show", "Surrender", and "Sacrifice".
